Summary

- **Network forensics are critical to security investigations. Properly deployed packet capture is unlikely to be manipulated by an attacker and as such can provide reliable, authoritative, actionable data to security investigation efforts. Topics covered include the benefits of packet capture in relation to security forensics, acquiring packets, placement of capture systems, storage requirements, the challenges presented by encrypted traffic, and visibility into virtual environments. The various ways of utilizing this critical data to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of security investigations will also be discussed.**
